

# CONNECTION LEARNING HEALTH SYSTEMS HUB-WIDE DATA SNAPSHOT RECENT TOBACCO SMOKING AND NICOTINE VAPING



The data below were collected from the Connection Learning Healthcare System Hub, which consists of Coordinated Specialty Care programs in Maryland and Pennsylvania.

These data reflect Coordinated Specialty Care service users within who have completed the admission timepoint of the Core Assessment Battery. This month's data show information about the nature of recent cigarette smoking and nicotine vaping in our sample. The sample size for this snapshot is service users who completed the Admission Core Assessment Battery from January 2021 – May 2023 and have data entered for the cigarette smoking and nicotine vaping questions.

## Cigarette Smoking at Admission

**20%** reported cigarette smoking in the last month



Out of 437 participants with cigarette smoking data at admission, 19.7%(86) reported cigarette smoking in the last month.

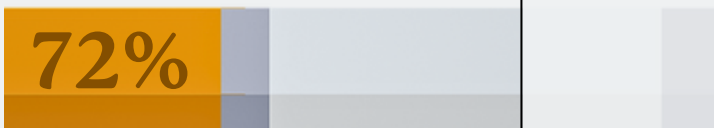
## Nicotine Vaping at Admission

**13%** reported nicotine vaping in the last month



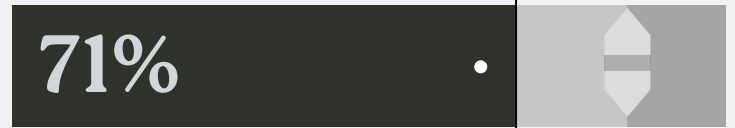
Out of 417 participants with nicotine vaping data at admission, 12.9% (n=54) reported nicotine vaping in the last month.

### Daily Cigarette Smoking at Admission



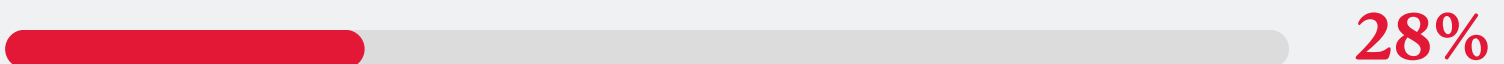
of cigarette smokers report **daily smoking** at admission (N = 83)
