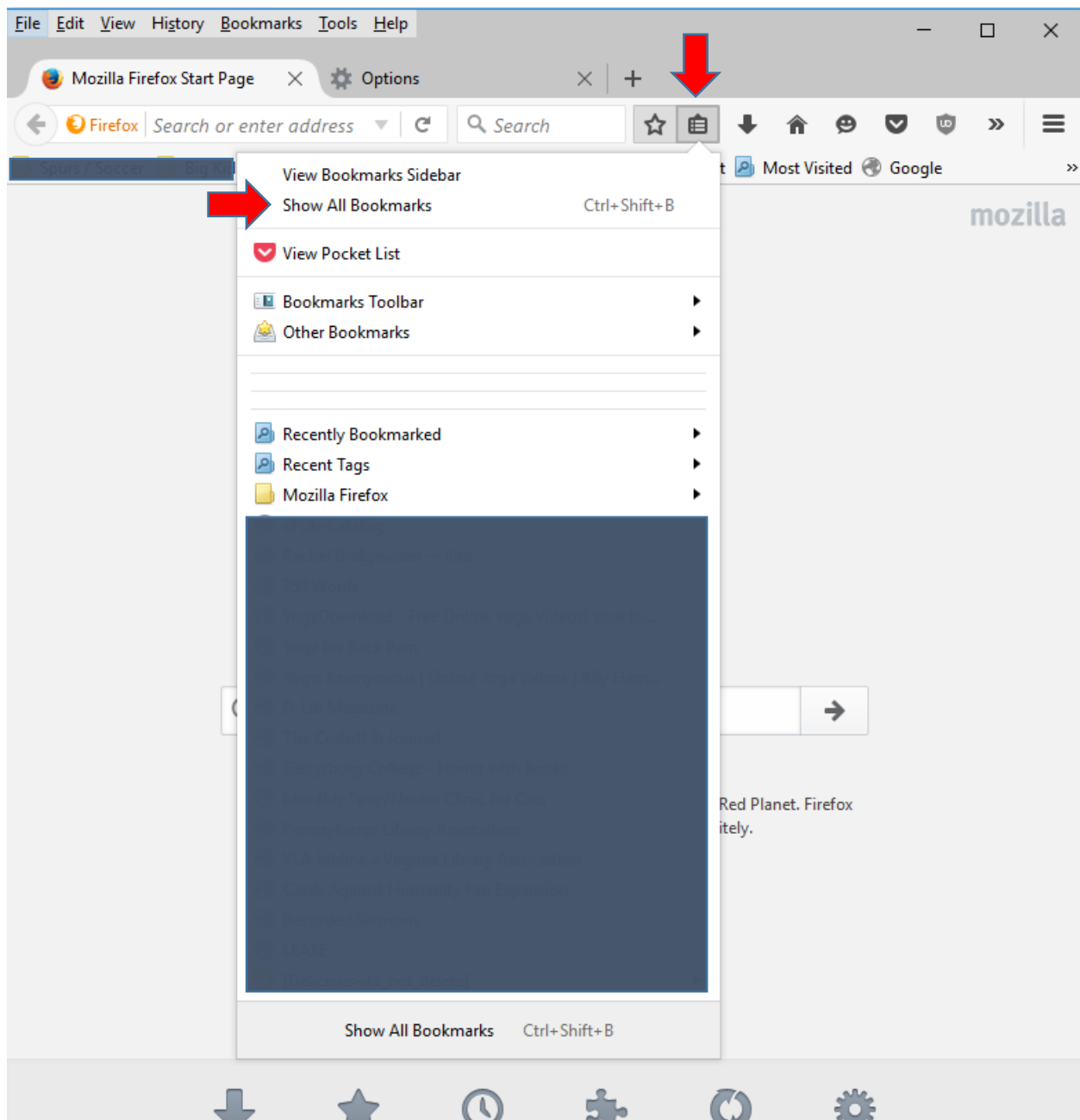


## Exporting and Importing **Mozilla Firefox** Favorites/Bookmarks

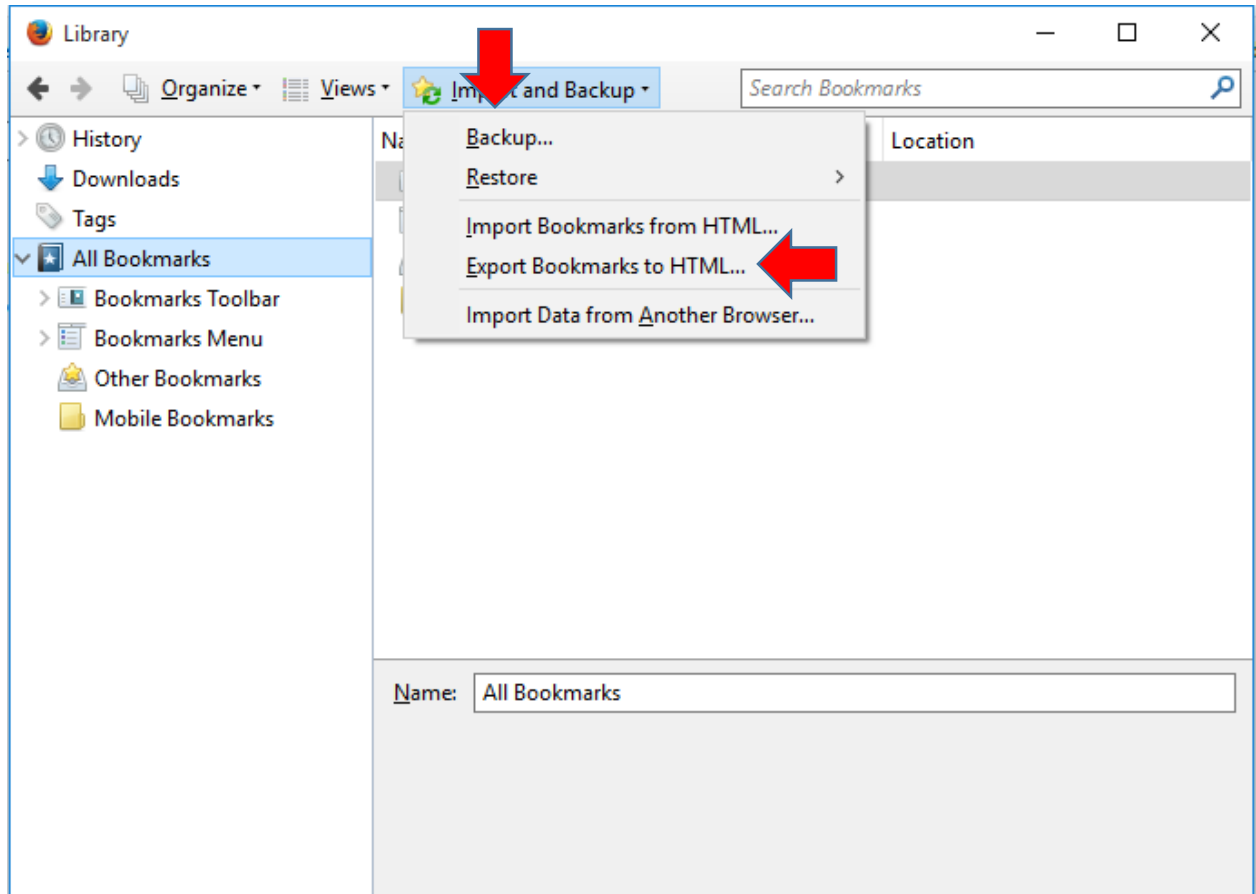
\*\*Mozilla Firefox supports Sync, which allows users to log in with an email address that will save users data and preferences such as bookmarks across different devices and computers. This is recommended to eliminate the need for backing up and restoring favorites after a reimage. ### Part I: Exporting Favorites

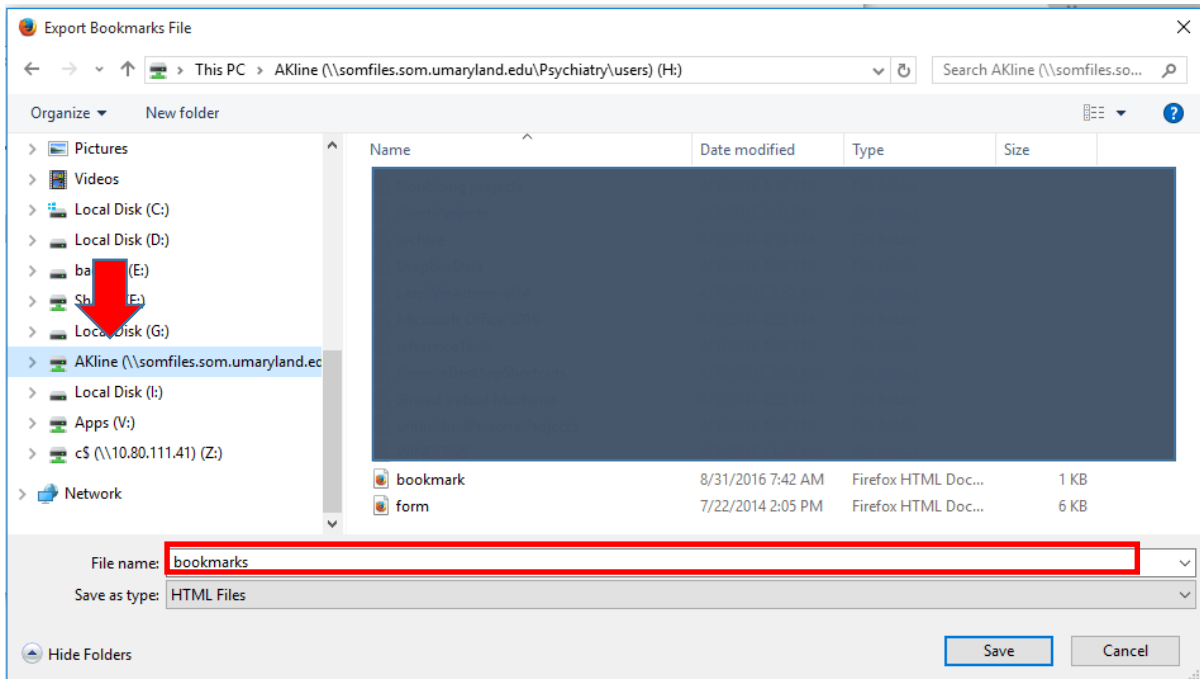
1. Open the Bookmarks library by either using the CTRL+SHIFT+B keys, or by clicking on the clipboard icon, then clicking on the 'Show All Bookmarks' option.



- At the bookmarks library dialog box, make sure that 'All Bookmarks' is selected in the left pane and then click 'Import and Backup'. Choose the option on the dropdown menu to 'Export Bookmarks to HTML...'



3. In the left pane, make sure to select your H: drive, and if you have multiple bookmark files saved in your home directory, provide a unique file name. Then click, 'Save'.

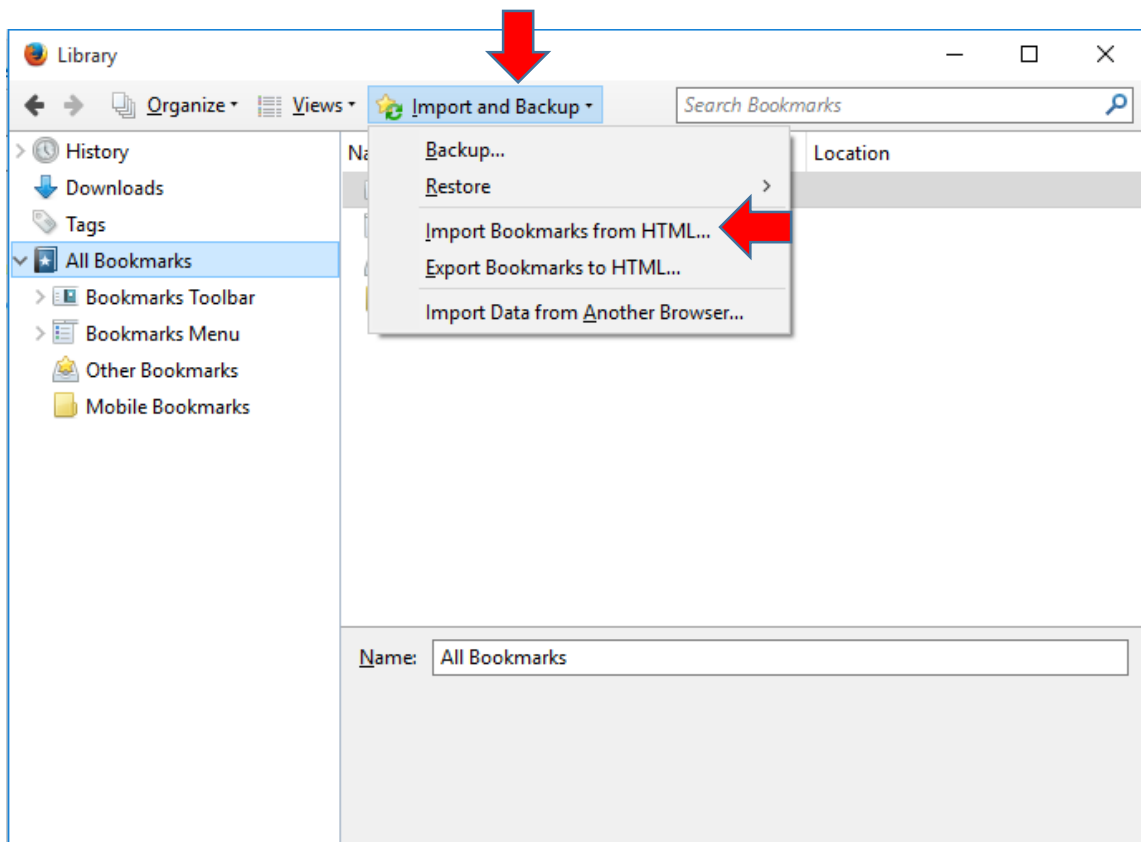


4. After you click 'Save', the dialog box will close. Your bookmarks are now saved in your home directory.

## ***Part II: Importing Favorites***

1. Follow step 1 of exporting favorites to open bookmark library dialog box.

- At the bookmarks library dialog box, make sure that 'All Bookmarks' is selected in the left pane and then click 'Import and Backup'. Choose the option on the dropdown menu to 'Import Bookmarks from HTML...



- In the left pane, make sure to select your H: drive, and locate the saved filename that you set when exporting. Click 'Open'. The file dialog box will close, and your bookmarks have been imported.
