As a mentor/teacher

- Obtain a prominent appointment as a volunteer faculty.
- Gain access to potential employees.
- Receive faculty development training.

Your commitment

- A minimum of 4 hours to a maximum of 160 hours of community-based teaching and mentoring per month.
- Mentor 1 student at a time.
- Provide feedback

Benefits

- Claim up to 60 credit hours in a 3-year cycle as member of AAFP.
- Apply for the Maryland Preceptor Tax Credit for up to \$10,000.*
- Eligibility for membership in the Medical Education Leadership Academy

Join our team of preceptors:

**Tax credits of \$1,000 are issued per eligible rotation. A minimum of three rotations of 100 hours each is required. Please see Income Tax Credit for Preceptors webpage.*

As a community-based licensed physician you are uniquely qualified to teach and mentor Maryland medical students. You can give back to your community by helping recruit healthcare professionals to your service area. You are also eligible for membership in the Medical Education Leadership Academy.

About our students:

University of Maryland Medical Students rotate with community preceptors during all four years of training. These rotations include the Primary Care Longitudinal Elective (PC-LE), Rural Health Equity and Access Longitudinal Elective (R-HEALE), third-year Family Medicine Clerkship, fourth-year Area Health Education Center (AHEC) rotation.
