Arm & Hand Recovery After Stroke

The University of Maryland is conducting a study to better understand recovery of the arm and hand over a 6-month time period after a stroke.

If qualified, subjects will participate in up to 7 evaluation sessions focusing on the arm and/or hand. Evaluations will include participation in functional tasks and movements as well as passive and active movement of the arm and hand by robots. Evaluations will take place over the span of 6 months at the rate of about 1 per month.

Participants must meet the following criteria:

- First and only unilateral stroke at least 2 weeks ago
- 18-85 years old
- Some arm and hand impairment
- No unrelated musculoskeletal issues in the arm or hand

Participants will receive compensation for each evaluation session (up to 7 sessions total)
