

The purpose of this table is to facilitate cross site communication and collaboration regarding services offered in Connection Learning Health System. All sites listed here offer the standard interventions and practices offered by Coordinated Specialty Care. These include psychoeducation about psychosis and recovery, evidence-based pharmacotherapy tailored for young people in the early stage of a mental illness with psychosis, individual counseling on topics related to first episode psychosis, case management, family education/support, peer support, supported education and employment services, crisis intervention services, primary care coordination, and community outreach. The columns listed here are interventions and practices that fit well with standard CSC, but are provided by some but not all sites.
