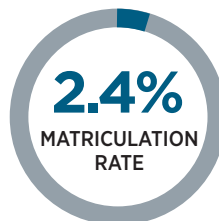

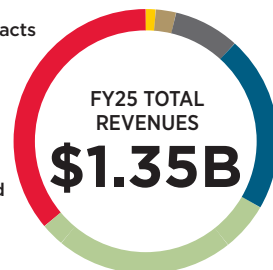
Aligning connection points for opioid use disorder health care access.
