IN THE NEWS

Hana L. Haver, MD, (PGY 5,) Jean Jeudy, MD, and Paul H. Yi, MD, were among the coauthors of a research letter published in *Radiology* entitled "Appropriateness of Breast Cancer Prevention and Screening Recommendations Provided by ChatGPT." Dr. Haver was the first author and Dr. Yi the last author. According to Dr. Yi, "The paper investigated

the accuracy of ChatGPT for giving breast cancer screening recommendations. We found that ChatGPT provided accurate recommendations regarding breast cancer screening for the vast majority of questions but did have some important inaccuracies. The major implication here is for the potential and pitfalls for ChatGPT and other large language models in educating patients about their healthcare."
