Endowed faculty support

Faculty professorships serve as a mark of distinction for generous donors and recognize the brightest minds in academic medicine—the faculty who inspire students, expand the frontiers of knowledge and make discoveries that change lives. A named chair can be established with a minimum gift of \$2.5 million. Named professorships can be established with a minimum of \$1.5 million in cumulative gifts for each professorship.

- Endowed clinical, research, and educational professorships in neuroscience, schizophrenia, mood disorders, child and adolescent disorders, addictions, severe mental illness and education
