

How to Create an Accordion and Tabs

There are two types:

1. **Advanced** - Use the SOM Advanced Module when you want to have the option to add content types inside the Accordion. This is used for Tabs as well.
2. **Simple**: Use the SOM Accordion Simple when you don't need the ability to have other content types inside the Accordion. This is only used for accordions (not tabs)

ADVANCED ACCORDION AND TABS

SOM Advanced Module

The following is an outline of content types. They are color coded to show the order.

SOM Advanced Module Start

SOM Tab/Accordion Item Start

Any Content Type(s) you want. Can be one or multiple.

SOM Tab/Accordion Item End

SOM Advanced Module End

Longer Version: Same thing, just with explanation

SOM Advanced Module Start (only once at the beginning - tells browser that tabs are starting)

SOM Tab/Accordion Item Start (this is the first tab. For example, 2019)

SOM A - HTML Content (This is the content *within* the tab. Use any content types you'd like. For example, HTML Content then SOM YouTube Video, etc.)

SOM Tab/Accordion Item End (use each time to end a tab)

SOM Tab/Accordion Item Start (this would be the second tab. For example, 2018)

SOM A - HTML Content (repeat or have different content types if you'd like)

SOM A – Horizontal Rule

SOM A - HTML Content

SOM Tab/Accordion Item End (use each time to end a tab)

SOM Advanced Module End (only once at end - tells browser that tabs are ending)

SIMPLE ACCORDION

This accordion does not allow other content types to be used. Only one simple accordion per page.

SOM Accordion Simple (only once at the beginning - tells browser that a simple accordion is starting)

SOM Accordion Simple Item (this has the name of the accordion and content that opens when clicked)

SOM Accordion Simple Item (same as above)

SOM Accordion Simple Item (same as above)

SOM Accordion Simple Item (same as above)
