All are welcome to attend MSRD. Please feel free to extend the invitation to your faculty mentors and other research colleagues. The event will begin with opening remarks and keynote address at 1:00 p.m. on Day 1, presentations from 2:15 - 5:30 p.m. on Day 1 and 1:00 - 2:20 p.m. on Day 2, and will conclude with the Awards segment at 3:30 - 4:30p.m. Please respond through the <u>MSRD Interest Form</u> by October 16 if planning to attend the event.

If you would like to present at MSRD, you must first register your presentation and then later submit your abstract. Presentation registration is currently open and due by September 29. Detailed information including eligibility and presentation registration are attached and can also be found in the "Presentation Registration" document available on the event webpage. Abstract submission for registered presentations will open on September 25 and close on October 16. Detailed instructions for abstract submission and procedures for presenting will be provided. Please note that prizes will be conveyed only to those awardees who are present at the awards banquet.
