



 - Smoking Prevention Activities Creative Antismoking Strategies/Activities








- Everyone is a winner!! More than one winner happens
- Can't win more than twice (2x) until everyone wins at least once
- Bus Passes \$1 Each (x2),
 Homeless/Hygiene Supplies, Battery
 Chargers, Flashlight, Blankets, Towels,
 Water Bottles <15\$
- 10 players Average Cost Per Class<155\$

Adults/Teens With Tobacco Related Disparities, Including but not limited to.


- Medical/Physical Health Neurological Conditions,
 Dehydration, Lack Of Sleep (Homelessness), Vision, Hearing
- Mental Health Concerns/ Psychosocial Factors, PTSD,
 Violence/Trauma, Fight or Flight, ACEs Trauma Informed,
 Illusions, Delusions, Anxiety, Paranoia
- Learning Disabilities/Differences Language Barriers,
 Reading Ability, Concentration Level
- Interpersonal Beliefs Culture, Racism, Fear Of Judgement,
 Multiple Promises/Staff, Stigma, Denial Of Problem
- Substance Use/Medications





Engagement Strategies

- Ability To Manage Challenging Behaviors Setting Limits
- Adaptive Techniques To Communicate Better
 - Repetition Voice Control
 - Early Arrival Consistency
 - Curriculum Development...
 - Reminders of Start Time Be Fluid
 - Body Awareness- Verbal And Non-verbal Cues, intuition
- Ensuring Accessibility and Adaptability Venue, Supplies
- Incorporating Multisensory Approaches,
 - Traditional Senses –Taste, Smell, Touch, Sight, Hearing Lollipops, Snacks, Fidget Toys






