- Have a high school diploma or GED.



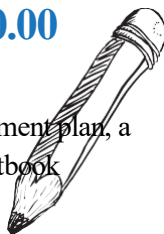
AHEC West Scholarships and other Workforce Development funds may be available to eligible individuals and/or employers to help with tuition costs.
